














# Asset Statuses, Out of Service and In Service Settings

The *Asset Statuses, Out of Service and In Service Settings* allows you to view, edit, delete, or create a new *Job / Asset Status*.

## Asset Status

Selecting *Add Status* at the top-left of the page triggers an input field in the existing list for you to add your new status title. You can also set it to indicate whether there is a fault with the asset, if it is out of service, or assign a color to the status as below:

Simply add your new status name and select *Update* to save. You can also select *Edit* or *Delete* existing items in the list.

## Out of Service Settings for Jobs

On each job, you can enable the recording Out of Service and In-Service Date/ Time Stamps. Useful for production and manufacturing environments e.g. to record that a line has been out of service as a result of a reported issue:
